

How to Measure Your Space for the Correct Rug Size

Living room, family rooms and dens:

Place your furniture where you think is best for the room. Measure the open space up to the sofa and chairs, making sure that when seated, both of your feet should be on the rug.

Allow approximately 8-12 inches of exposed floor between baseboards and rug on all sides. More than one rug is acceptable.

Dinning Room:

Pull the chairs away from the table, as you would to sit down, on both sides and the ends. Measure from the rear chair legs in width and length. Add 8 inches to this total measurement. This will give you the minimum size rug needed.

Bedrooms:

If the rug is under the bed, allow 3 feet of exposed rug on both sides of the bed.
